

ELIGIBILITY RULES FOR SKATERS

INDONESIA ICE SKATING OPEN 2020 @ BINTARO JAYA

1. All competition events are open to both amateur skaters and professional coaches.
2. All competitors must be a current Individual Member or Associate Member of ISIAAsia or ISI through **February 20, 2020**.
3. All competitors must compete at their highest test level passed and **all tests must be registered with ISIAAsia in Hong Kong or ISI-USA by February 20, 2020**.
4. All competitors must represent a current ISIAAsia or ISI Administrative Member rink, club or skating school. It is permissible to represent one Administrative member for individual/partner events and a different Administrative member for team/group events.
5. Skaters in Pre-Alpha-Delta may not compete in Figure 1, Freestyle 1, Couple 1, or Pair 1. If the skater has passed any one of those tests, then they can no longer compete in Pre-Alpha to Delta level events. Skaters below FS1 can participate in Ice Dance events (after passing the required Ice Dance tests) without having to pass the Delta test.
6. Skating coaches, and members of other skating organizations are eligible and welcome to compete in the ***“Indonesia Ice Skating Open 2020 @ Bintaro Jaya”*** competition as long as they are also current Individual or Professional Members of ISIAAsia or ISI; they have their ISI tests passed and registered with ISIAAsia or ISI-USA by latest **February 20, 2020**; and they represent an ISI member rink.
7. All skaters are expected to compete at their true ability level and all coaches are expected to uphold high ethical standards.
8. Each event will be divided by age groups according to entries received with no more than 9 entries in a group. Females and Males are separated in most technical events, but they may be combined in Artistic, Couples Spotlight, Family Spotlight, Footwork, Interpretive, Jump & Spin Teams, Spotlight Solo, Stroking, Surprise, and all Team Events at the discretion of the Competition Director.

This ***“Indonesia Ice Skating Open 2020 @ Bintaro Jaya”*** competition will use the first day of competition **February 20, 2020** as the age cut-off date for grouping individual event skaters; and for all team event skaters.
9. There will be a short warm-up period before each event – a 2-minute warm-up will be held for Solo Compulsories, Jump & Spin Teams, and all other Team Events. There is **NO WARM-UP** for Speedracing, Stroking, or Surprise events. **NO BACKWARD ARABESQUES / SPIRALS** are permitted during any warm-up for the safety of all skaters.
10. Specific performance criteria for every competition event can be found in the 2018 edition of the **ISI Skaters & Coaches Handbook**. **It is the coach’s responsibility to make sure they are up-to-date with the**

current rule revisions and event information. Please refer to the additional information (listed on this website) before preparing your competition programs to avoid unnecessary penalties or deductions.

11. Individual medals will be awarded for 1st – 9th place winners. All skaters not placing 1st – 3rd will receive a 4th place medal. Overall Team Champion Trophies will be presented to each participating rink team.
12. Medals for Team Events will only be awarded for registered skaters in the Team Events Form.
13. All events will be team point events. For all individual and partner events, 1st Place skaters will earn 5 points for their rink team. For 2nd Place, 4 points will be awarded. For 3rd Place – 3 points, 4th Place – 2 points, and 5th Place – 1 point. In addition, each event entry will receive 1 team point for participation.
14. For Kaleidoskate, Pattern, Production, Synchronized Teams, and Team Compulsory events: 1st Place winners will receive 25 team points; 2nd Place – 20 points; 3rd Place – 15 point; 4th Place – 10 points; 5th Place – 5 points. In addition, each team event entry will receive 5 team points for participation.
15. **All completed Entry Forms and payments (T/T wire transfers only) must be received by BX Rink – Bintaro latest December 19, 2019 to avoid the double fee charges. COMPETITION ENTRY & TESTING DEADLINES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** Late entries will only be accepted after approval of the Competition Director, and after the double fee payments are received.

NO ENTRY FEE OR CHANGE FEE REFUND WILL BE GIVEN UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

16. Fill-out the entry forms carefully and completely including all required signatures. **Any change from the original entry forms will be charged a change fee of Rp.100.000,- PER SKATER / PER CHANGE.** These change fees must be received by the **BX Rink** before any changes are made in the Event Schedule.
17. Please be sure to note your partner's name, age, & sex on your form if you are participating in Couples, Dance, Pairs, Couples Spotlight, Family Spotlight, or Jump & Spin events. Each skater must submit a separate entry form.
18. As a reward for their achievement, all skaters who have pass any level 9-10 test in Freestyle, are entitled to **one complimentary first event entry** at "Indonesia Ice Skating Open 2020 @ Bintaro Jaya".
19. Vocal music is permitted for all ISI competition events. There is no penalty for skating under any prescribed program duration time
