- 3. Language: Mandarin Chinese is the official language, but many people in Taiwan also speak English, especially in tourist areas and larger cities. Learning a few basic phrases in Mandarin can be helpful.
- 4. Food: Taiwanese cuisine is diverse and delicious. Don't miss trying local specialties like beef noodle soup, bubble tea, and night market snacks. Taiwan is also known for its vibrant night markets.
