4. Individual medals will be awarded to the top 5 winners, with medals given for 1st - 5th place. Skaters who do not place in the top 5 will receive a 5th place medal. Additionally, Overall Team Champion Trophies will be awarded to each participating rink team.

5. Special awards will be presented for the Youngest Skater, Oldest Skater, Highest Level Skater, Most Medal Skater and Most Promising Skater. These awards are intended to foster a well-rounded and inclusive atmosphere at Skate Johor 2026. *(Please note that the Highest Level Skater award will be given only to skaters participating in Solo Program and/or Open Freestyle events.)*

6. We are delighted to announce that skaters in the Highest ISI Test Levels FS8-10 will have their First Event entry fee covered by the organizers. Coaches participating will also have their First and Second Event entry fees covered. Subsequent entry fees will be in accordance with the stated entry fees.
